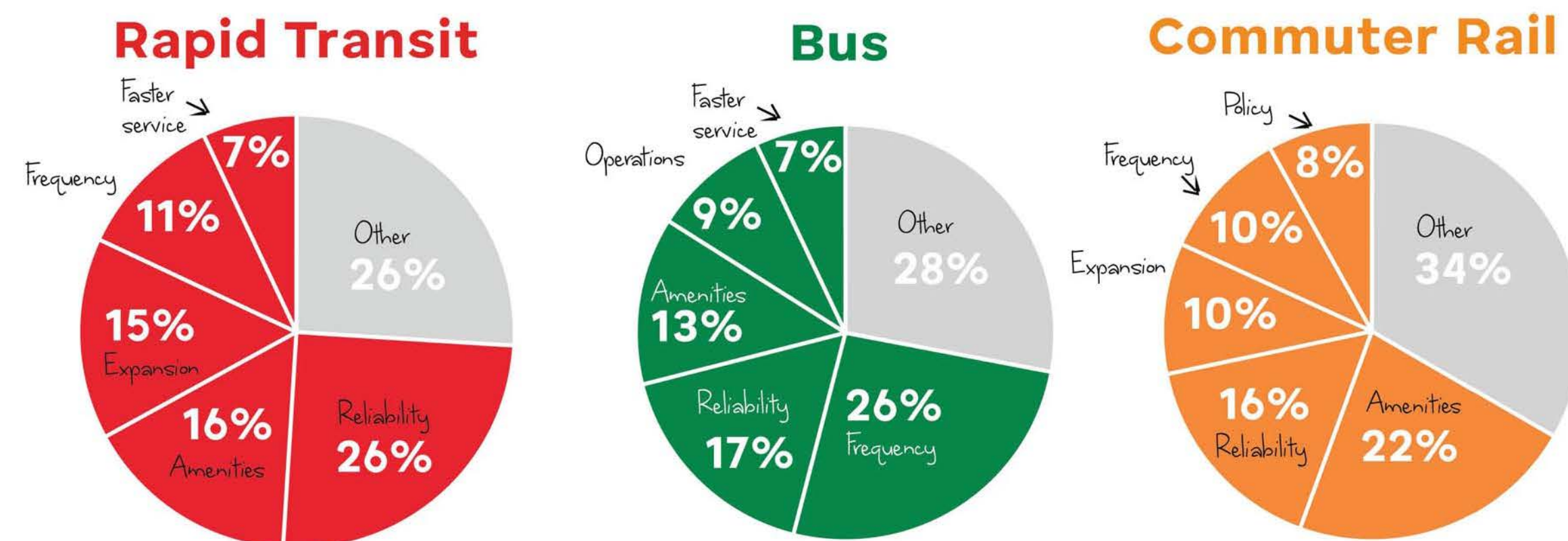


WHAT WE HEARD FROM YOU

What we heard by mode



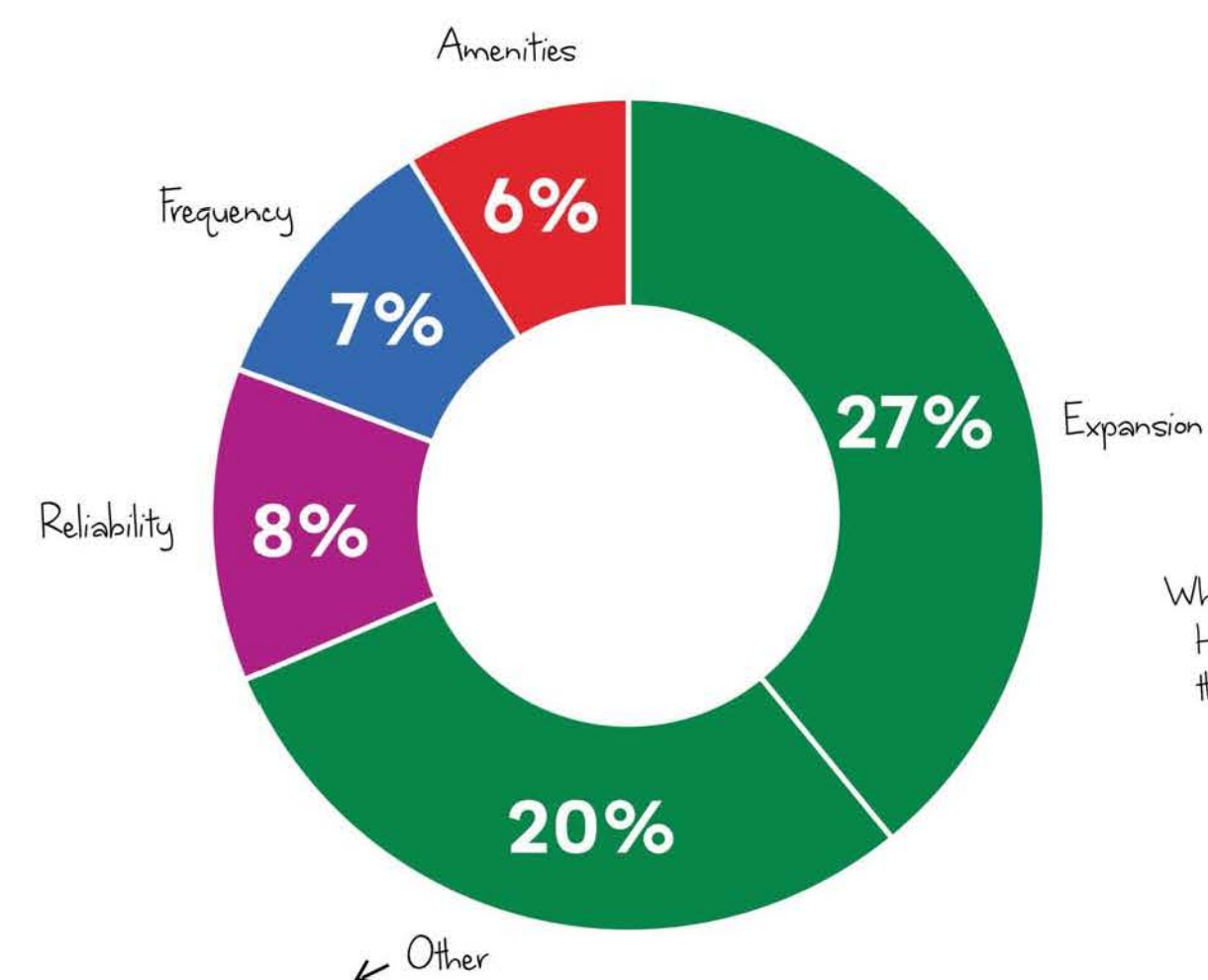
Other includes comments related to emission reduction, transit priority, parking capacity, etc.

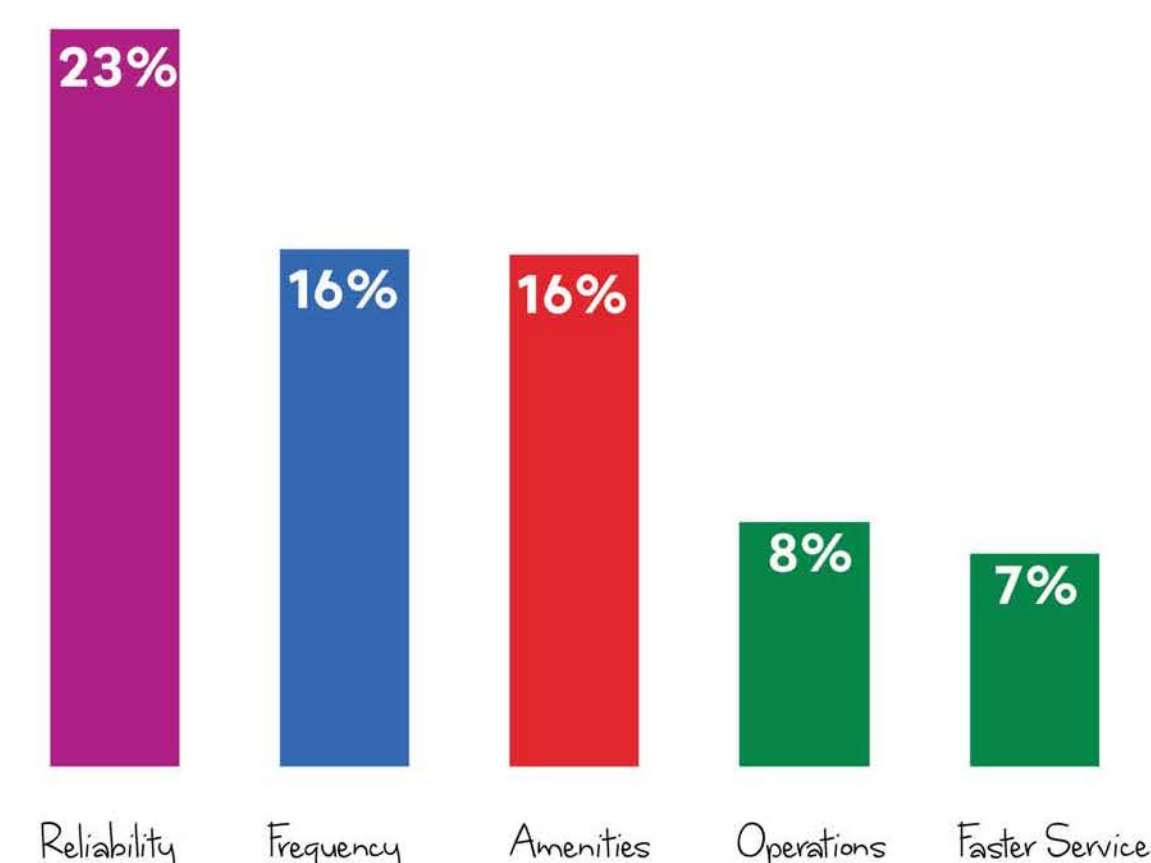


Top 5 Comments from our website and stakeholders
